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I. Rules

III. Tardy policy

As you enter the classroom, you need to get any materials, sharpen your pencil, be seated, and begin working on the assignment. The door will close when the bell rings and you will be required to go to the tardy sweep location.

IV. Restroom Policy

Students will receive 5 hall passes per semester. Students will be required to turn in a hall pass to go to the restroom during class. After all 5 passes have been used, students will not be allowed to go during class. It is best to schedule restroom breaks between classes and NOT during class if possible.

V. Cell Phone Policy

- 5 points will be deducted for No Name on an Assignment. Any "No Names" will be posted and remain for a certain amount of time and then disregarded.
- 5 points will be deducted from an assignment if a student's handwriting is unreadable or too small to see.
- 5 points will be deducted from an assignment if a student uses any other color ink besides blue or black.
- 5 points will be deducted from an assignment if a student doodles or draws on assignment.

VII. Absences and Make-up Work

When you are absent from school, it is YOUR responsibility to collect and turn in make up work. Pick up make up assignments from the make-up area in the classroom. You will have one day for every day you are absent to make up any work. **Quizzes and tests are to be made up during tutorials**. Please make up your work in a timely manner as this makes things easier for ALL OF US.

IX. Late Work

Late work will only be accepted within ONE day of the original due date and with a starting grade of 70. Once the grading period has passed for that assignment, it will not be accepted (district policy). Please see me for extenuating circumstances.
